Internet-based information systems, the second covering the large-scale in- gration of heterogeneous computing systems and data resources with the aim of providing a global computing space.

Each of these four conferences encourages researcher to treat their respective

topics within a framework that incorporates jointly (a) theory, (b) conceptual design and development, and (c) applications, in particular case studies and industrial solutions. Hector Jul 01 2020 The present volume and volume I "Hector: New Ways in Education and Research" present the results of HECTOR, the four year cooperation project between the University of Karlsruhe and IBM Germany (represented by the European Networking Center and Scientific Center in Heidelberg as well as IBM Research in Riischlikon). The project was started

in spring 1984 and will end in April 1988 with a congress. This congress addresses the scientific community to present experiences and results with a program of lectures and demonstrations. The HECTOR Project has two major aspects: the first is to explore new ways in university education. The second aspect of HECTOR comprises basic research work to develop new technological concepts for the establishment of computer communication networks, supporting academic research and education in all disciplines. The underlying concept

is that now and in the future, computer, software and communication systems which are required for the broad range of scientific and educational tasks will be of different technical orientation and made by different manufacturers. These diverse systems will, however, need to coexist and cooperate side by side. Today, in most cases, different hardware and software architectures of different manufacturers prevent a scientist or student from choosing freely the computer and software which offers the best alternative for solving his or her current problem.

The mutual cooperation of the academic users is also hindered substantially by the many incompatibilities present. The users' future is therefore transparency in a heterogeneous environment.

particular property.  
A resource correspon-  
ds to  
an information source  
such as a data  
repository or  
database manage-  
ment system (e. g. , a  
query form or a  
textual search  
engine), a link  
between resources  
(an index or  
hyperlink), or a  
service such as an app-  
lication or a tool.  
Resources are charac-  
terized by core infor-  
mation including a  
name, a description  
of its input and its  
output (parameters  
or format), its

address, and various additional properties expressed as metadata. Resources are organized with respect to metadata that characterize their content (for data sources), their semantics (in terms of ontological classes and relationships), their characteristics (syntactical properties), their performance (with metrics and benchmarks), their quality (curation, reliability, trust), etc. Resource discovery systems allow the expression of queries to identify and - cate resources that implement speci?c tasks. Machine-based resource discovery relies on crawling, clustering, and

classifying resources discovered on the Web automatically. The First Workshop on Resource Discovery (RED) took place on November 25, 2008 in Linz, Austria. It was organized jointly with the 10th International Conference on Information Integration and Web-Based Applications and Services and its proceedings were published by ACM. The second edition of the workshop was co-located with the 35th International Conference on Very Large Data Bases (VLDB) in the beautiful city of Lyon, France. Nine papers were selected for presentation at this

second edition.
